The Registration of Clubs (Accounts) Regulations (NI) '22

Section 12 of the Licensing and Registration of Clubs (Amendment) Act (NI) 2011 amends Article 40 of the Registration of Clubs (NI) Order 1996 and will come into operation on 1 April 2022. The associated clubs accounts regulations were made on 10 March 2022 and will also come into operation on 1 April 2022.

The Registration of Clubs (Accounts) Regulations (NI) 2022 revokes the Registration of Clubs (Accounts) Regulations (NI)1997. Further information can be obtained <a href="https://example.com/here/here/https://example.com/

Charities Act (NI) '22

If your club is a registered charity then please note that an important new law, the Charities Act (NI) 2022, is about to come into force. This will mean a number of changes for charities in Northern Ireland.

Gameday/NV Play System

The NCU Board has agreed to the phased implementation of this system. How we manage our competitions is a very outdated system and the time has come for us to start the switch to using technology to automate as much of the process as possible.

In the 2022 season it will be used to manage competitions. The system can also be utilised by clubs in 2022 to manage their club membership and score their games. Although there is no requirement for clubs to do this, and so for many the 2022 season will be the same as last season.

How the system will work

Club member registrations will be managed through the Gameday part. When clubs send member registration forms to the NCU, we will upload these into system creating hubs for each club to manage their own membership. Through time this will evolve to allow every club member to create their own unique page.

With member registration detail inputted, this will then allow match cards to be created in the NV Play part of the system. In this part of the system matches can be scored with club and player stats available in real time. There is no requirement for clubs to score matches using this system, but it is hoped that many will utilise it. Through time features like live streaming and game analysis can be introduced.
